FOR A TRAFFIC STOP Keep toys in your trunk rather than in plain sight.

FOR A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE/DISTURBANCE CALL

- Ask your partner to talk to the police. Explain that you're engaged in "mutually pleasurable kink activities between consenting adults that don't involve serious injury."
- Since some BDSM acts are likely illegal in your State, request to speak to your attorney before answering any questions beyond "mutually pleasurable kink activities between consenting adults...", or "We practice Explicit Prior Permission as per the Model Penal Code on Sexual Assault Section 213.10." Tell them: **YOU ENJOY IT, KNOW HOW TO DO IT SAFELY, and CAN STOP AT ANY TIME.**

IN EVERY INTERACTION

- Use COMMON SENSE.
- Provide your ID if asked.
- Follow instructions.
- Be POLITE and Stay CALM.
- Stand aside when saying, "I don't give you permission to enter" or "I don't give you permission to search," - you can't stop a law enforcement officer if they think they have probable cause of a crime being committed.
